### About the seminar

The Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorist Financing (Financial Institutions) (Amendment) Bill 2017 was passed in the Legislative Council on 24 January 2018. Customer due diligence and record keeping are new legislative requirements on accountants and trust or company service providers ("TCSP") that prepare for or carry out specified transactions for their clients. The new regulations are effective from 1 March 2018.

#### This seminar aims to:

- Update the participants on the requirements in the new legislation relevant to accountants.
- Enhance understanding of the statutory obligations and practices of suspicious transaction reporting.
- Update participants on the key requirements in the AML guidelines issued by the Institute.
- Provide a forum for discussion on matters of common concern on AML compliance and suspicious transaction reporting.
