Stock Exchange's Review of Financial Statements and Corporate Governance Disclosures in Annual Reports

About the topic

The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (Stock Exchange) released its latest reports on findings arising from its Financial Statements Review Programme (FSRP) and its analysis of corporate governance disclosures in annual reports. The reports were released in August and September 2010 respectively. Key observations and findings from the two reviews are summarised in the reports. Through publishing the findings the Stock Exchange aims to promote higher standards of disclosure and corporate governance by listed issuers.

At this seminar, Mr. Colin Chau, a Senior Vice President of the Listing Division of the Stock Exchange, will talk on the following topics:
