

PAIB Seminar: Developments in Hong Kong's offshore RMB business

About the topic and speaker

One of the important areas of growth for Hong Kong as an international financial centre is the development of offshore renminbi (RMB) business. Since RMB business was introduced in Hong Kong in 2004, there has been significant growth in both the depth and breadth of the market and product development, which among others, includes cross-border trade settlement and related banking services, bond issuance and the introduction of various related financial products. So, what are the opportunities for the corporate sector and what is the significance of Hong Kong's role in the internationalisation of the RMB?

At this seminar, Mr. Stephen Wan from the Hong Kong Monetary Authority (HKMA) will talk about the current developments in offshore RMB business in Hong Kong, the opportunities for Hong Kong as a centre of RMB cross-border trade settlement, financing and wealth management, as well as the roles of regulators in promoting and supporting the business.

At the HKMA, Mr. Wan's responsibilities include financial cooperation with Mainland China, development of offshore renminbi business in Hong Kong and issues relating to multilateral agencies.
