

PAIB forum – How would IESBA's proposed changes to Part C of the ethics code affect PAIBs?

About the topic

The next PAIB forum will explain the <u>International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants</u> ("IESBA") exposure draft ("ED") on <u>Proposed changes to Part C of the Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants</u> ("Code") addressing presentation of information and pressure to breach the fundamental principles. This ED aims to provide practical guidance to PAIBs to deal with two common matters in practice: (i) their responsibility to produce financial reports that are faithful representations of the economics of transactions, and (ii) the issue of pressure to breach fundamental ethical principles.

As this ED deals primarily with the ethical responsibilities of PAIBs, PAIBs' views and comments would therefore be important for the Institute to prepare its response to IESBA.

At the forum, in addition to the technical part – bringing the participants' attention to the salient changes to Part C of the Code, there will be PAIB members leading the discussion of the impact of the ED on PAIBs.
