ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Mr. Rico Leung is currently Senior Director, Supervision of Markets Division of the Securities & Futures Commission (SFC). The Division is responsible for supervising the Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited in respect of its trading and clearing activities, authorisation of automated trading systems, managing the investor compensation funds and facilitating the development of the securities and futures markets. Rico has about 20 years experience in the securities and derivatives markets. Prior to joining the SFC in October 2000, he was Chief Operations Officer of HKFE Clearing Corporation Limited (a wholly-owned subsidiary of Hong Kong Futures Exchange) in charge of clearing operations and risk management of the derivatives market.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

In the wake of the recent financial crisis, there have been various regulatory reform proposals underway in the US and Europe. While Hong Kong is less affected by this crisis, the SFC has been keeping a close eye on international developments to ensure that the regulatory regime in Hong Kong is effective and efficient. In addition, there are domestic issues that may call for regulatory changes. This seminar will examine some of the regulatory issues being proposed or considered by the SFC. They include:

- 1. Development of dark pools or alternative trading venues
- 2. Short selling regulation
- 3. Implementation of a scripless securities market
