ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The IASB and FASB released an exposure draft on Revenue Recognition Standard in June 2010. Once the new standard becomes effective, HKAS 11 and all existing revenue recognition guidance under HKFRS will be replaced. Further to the seminar in December 2009, we will update the development of the proposed standard and share the common issues in the Engineering and Construction Industry.
