Mr. Alan C.W. Tang, with almost 30 years of experience in insolvency and related work, is widely recognized as an expert in PRC bankruptcy and restructuring matters. His first case involving Hong Kong – PRC cross border issues started in 1986. He possesses extensive experience in restructuring, investigation and insolvency; bankruptcy and individual voluntary arrangements; and expert witness, forensic accounting and litigation support.

Alan writes extensively and speaks at international conferences on insolvency and related topics. He taught on the INSOL International Fellowship Programme and spoke at various INSOL International, TMA, FAIR and EAAIR Conferences. He also spoke at the last two PRC Bankruptcy Law Symposiums organized by the Supreme People's Court. In June 2012, he was invited by the World Bank et. al. to be part of an international team of experts to give a week-long training to some 200 bankruptcy judges from all over the PRC. At the invitation of Sweet & Maxwell Asia, he wrote and published a book on "Insolvency in China and Hong Kong – A Practitioner's Perspective" in 2005. His recent publications include INSOL International's Technical Series No. 9. and No. 24, as well as Case No. 5 in INSOL International's Workshop Series. His paper (in Chinese) on cross-border issues was also published in the Symposium Pack for the 5th PRC Bankruptcy Law Symposium in November 2012.

Mr. Tang holds an MSc (Econ) in Accounting and Finance from the London School of Economics and Political Science. He is a fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of CPAs, the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales and the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants.

Mr. Tang was Chairman of the Insolvency Practitioners Committee ("IPC") of the Institute for four terms, from 2004 to 2007, when he was also a director on the Board of INSOL International, representing the Institute. He saw the profession's transformation from the IPC to the RIF in 2008 and is currently convenor of the Mainland Issues Working Group of the RIF.
