He is one of the pioneers of Taiwan's international securities practice, representing international underwriters with respect to Global Depositary Receipt (GDR), American Depositary Receipt (ADR) and Exchangeable Corporate Bond (ECB) offerings by Taiwan companies.

Dr. Chuang has extensive experience in high-tech industries since 1987, serving as a director on the boards of over ten high-tech companies and a venture capital firm in Taiwan. He is also a frequent speaker for many organizations, including the Securities and Futures Institute, a non-profit organization sponsored by Taiwan's Securities and Futures Bureau, covering topics related to corporate and securities laws as well as corporate governance in Taiwan. Dr. Chuang has also taught at both the Law School and the Graduate School of Accounting of Soochow University in Taiwan for more than ten years.

Dr. Chuang is a member of the California Bar Association. He is a former member of the Committee for Screening Applications for Listing on the Taiwan Stock Exchange and the Committee for Screening Applications for Listing on the National Association of Securities Companies (now the Gre-Tai Securities Trading Center). He is also a former advisor to Taiwan's Securities and Futures Commission and the National Association of Securities Companies. Dr. Chuang also served as a member of the taskforce that drafted the amendment to Taiwan's Securities and Exchange Law in 1989.
