PAIB Forum: Directors' & Officers' Liabilities and Mitigating the Risks

About the topic

In recent years the profile and focus on the liabilities faced by directors and officers has changed significantly. Corporate scandals in the USA have highlighted the exposures of directors to legal liabilities. Here in Asia the exposures directors face through litigation is increasing across the region, and a "culture of blame" that seeks to apportion fault, responsibility and redress at law, is sprouting.

Speakers from an international law firm, DLA Piper Hong Kong, and insurance brokers and risk consultants, Jardine Lloyd Thompson (JLT) will provide a thought-provoking presentation on how these issues/cases can develop, followed by an introduction of directors and officers liability insurance (D&O insurance) and how it can protect directors' and officers' interests in these situations.

The presentation will be conducted in two parts:

Part 1: "Counting the Cost": a hypothetical scenario that demonstrates how poor corporate governance can spiral into fraud, illustrated in an acclaimed short film, commissioned by DLA.

Part 2: D&O Insurance: an introductory presentation about D&O insurance and explanation on how it operates, drawing both on issues arising from the film shown in Part 1 and also real life examples of what has been happening in Hong Kong and the region.
