**Ms. Choi Suk Han, Annie**, joined the Hong Kong Government in 1986. She has worked in a number of policy bureaux and departments, including the Home Affairs Department, Civil Service Bureau, Health and Welfare Bureau, Innovation and Technology Commission, Environment and Food Bureau, as well as the Environment, Transport and Works Bureau. Between June 2007 and August 2009, Ms Choi was the Deputy Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, overseeing policies and legislation on consumer protection and postal services, support for local trade and industry, as well as economic and trade issues related to the Mainland and Hong Kong. Ms Choi assumed the position of Commissioner of Insurance in September 2009.

Ms Choi obtained her bachelor and master degrees in Laws as well as Postgraduate Certificate in Laws from the University of Hong Kong. She also did postgraduate studies in Public Administration at the Oxford University, UK and Tsinghua University, PRC.
