Prof. Chan is both an academic in social gerontology and a practitioner in welfare services for the elderly. Started his career as a nurse and later on as a social worker serving the elderly, Prof. Chan is experienced in health and social care services as well as policy-making in related areas. Before joining the Equal Opportunities Commission, he was the chairman of Elderly Commission and director of Asia-Pacific Institute of Ageing Studies, Lingnan University.

In addition to the Elderly Commission, Prof. Chan has served in many advisory bodies of the Hong Kong SAR Government, including the Elderly Care Service Industry Training Advisory Committee under Qualifications Framework of Education Bureau, the Population Expert Group of Central Policy Unit, the Independent Police Complaints Council, the Statistics Advisory Board of Census and Statistics Department and the Minimum Wage Commission. He is also a member of the Hong Kong World Health Organisation Quality of Life Instruments (Elderly) Study Team and a consultant on ageing and social development issues for the United Nations Economics and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific. From June 2011, Prof. Chan has been appointed as the advisor for International Longevity Centre of the Tsao's Foundation of Singapore and National University of Singapore.
