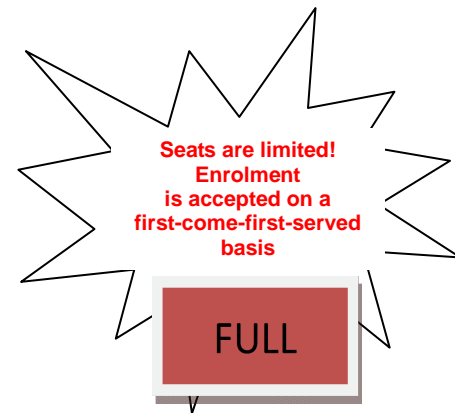

Highlights In November 2015 ICAS launched its 'The Power of One' campaign. The aim of this to help re-establish ethics at the core of business practices and to rebuild public trust in business.

Through their ethical behaviour, professional accountants are a force for good in the organisations in which they work. They can also influence those around them, and thereby help shape the culture and values of their organisation. The cumulative effect of their influence can help reinforce the importance of ethics at the core of business practices and of a more responsible and holistic approach to business. In this way, professional accountants are a key component of building public trust in business, to the benefit of our broader society.

Anton Colella and James Barbour will explain the background to the initiative, explain the key themes of 'The Power of One', and provide an update on the activity to date and that which is planned for the future. Raphael Ding will provide his insights about the importance of business ethics.
