# Shaping the Future of Sustainability Reporting in Hong Kong - Exposure Drafts on HKFRS Sustainability Disclosure Standards

(Programme code: EWEB24100401)

The Financial Reporting Standards Committee of the HKICPA is seeking comments on the Exposure Drafts for HKFRS S1 General Requirements for Disclosure of Sustainability-related Financial Information and HKFRS S2 Climate-related Disclosures (HK EDs).

The HKFRS S1 and S2 (HKFRS Sustainability Disclosure Standards) are crucial for aligning Hong Kong's sustainability reporting with global baseline, enhancing consistency and comparability to meet investors' needs.

#### **Key Highlights of the HK EDs include:**

- **Full Convergence:** The HKICPA is proposing full convergence of HKFRS S1 and S2 with IFRS S1 and S2, to be effective from 1 August 2025.
- International Significance: Hong Kong's proposed full convergence with the ISSB Standards has global significance as it would bolster global capital flows with local business as well as those in mainland China and other regions. It would also promote interoperability across jurisdictions.
- **Voluntary Application:** HKFRS S1 and S2 will be voluntary until relevant authorities mandate their use.
- Priortisation of listed entities and regulated financial institutions: As indicated in the HKSAR
  Government's Vision Statement on Turning Obligations into Opportunities in Developing the
  Sustainability Disclosure Ecosystem in Hong Kong, the application of HKFRS S1 and S2 will
  prioritise publicly accountable entities including listed entities and regulated financial institutions
  in Hong Kong such as banks, fund managers, insurance companies and MPF trustees.
