However, if you are submitting your application in person and do not have certified true copies of academic records, originals of all academic records with photocopies should be produced for inspection and certification by the Institute.
- 4. Applicants who have completed the PRC CPA Uniform Examination Under the agreement signed between the Hong Kong Institute of CPAs and CICPA, Hong Kong Institute of CPAs will forward the following documents to CICPA for certification purpose: "Certificate of Completion" (全科合格证) of the PRC CPA Uniform Examination (全国统一考试) or CICPA membership certificate, 2 photographs and Identity Card / Passport.

#### Notes:

- a. First Registration fee, First Subscription fee and Non-Hong Kong Degree Assessment fee (if any) are the fees payable by a new applicant for initial registration as a student. These fees are not refundable when the application is not accepted.
- b. Annual Subscription fee is due on 1 January of each year. Students with a registration date between 1 January and 31 December 2010 will have to pay for their annual subscription for 2011 on or before 31 December 2010.
- c. For students who have notified the Institute before 15 December of the year that they wish to resign from the Institute and have no fees outstanding, on re-registration, they are only required to pay the Re-registration fee (\$450) + Annual Subscription fee (\$450) = \$900.
- d. For students who resign after 15 December, or are removed from the Register for non-payment of Annual Subscription or for any other reason, such as disciplinary action, on re-registration, they are required to pay an additional Penalty Fee equivalent to the Annual Subscription, i.e. they are required to pay the Re-registration fee (\$450) + Annual Subscription fee (\$450) + Penalty fee (\$450) = \$1,350.
- e. Applicants who have been rejected as a result of not meeting the requisite standard of education are required to pay the Re-application fee and Annual Subscription fee for re-application.
- f. Includes the Candidate Learning Pack, Module Workshops and Module Examination.
- g. Includes both Papers I and II of the final examination.





# Supplementary Note for Mainland Applicants under the HKICPA/CICPA Agreement on Mutual Examination Paper Exemption (MEPE)

#### Student Registration Requirements

- (i) should be a recognised degree holder;
- (ii) should have passed the PRC CPA Uniform Examination with Certificate of Completion (全科合格証) or CICPA members not qualified by completion of PRC CPA Uniform Examination and have registered as a member of CICPA on or before 29 July 2008; and
- (iii) should have achieved one of the following English competency standards:
  - Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
    - Paper-based test: a score of 550 or above; or
    - Computer-based test: a score of 213 or above; or
    - Internet-based test: a score of 79 or above
  - International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
    - Overall band of 6.5 or above
  - Chinese Mainland's College English Test (CET)
    - Band 6; or
    - A total mark of 450 or above in the new CET-6
  - Overseas General Certificate of Education /
     International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)
    - Grade C or above
  - Cambridge Test of Proficiency in English Language (Cambridge Test)
    - Grade C or above for English taken as the <u>first</u> language; or
    - Grade B or above for English taken as the second language

#### Conditional Enrolment

Applicants who have achieved the following **minimum English competency standards** for QP entry will be conditionally admitted to the QP and allowed to take Module D (Taxation). However, they must have achieved the prescribed English standard before being allowed to enroll in the Final Examination of the QP.

- International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
  - Overall band of 6.0 or above
- Chinese Mainland's College English Test (CET)
  - Band 4: or
  - A total mark of 450 or above in the new CET-4
- Public English Test System (PETS)
  - Band 4

#### Practical Experience Requirements for CPA Membership

In order to meet the requirements for CPA membership of the Institute, apart from successful completion of the QP professional examinations, students are also required to comply with the competency-based Practical Experience Framework (PEF). For relevant experience gained outside Hong Kong by registered students on or after 1 January 2005, such experience will be recognized only if it is gained under an Authorized Employer/ Supervisor (AE/AS). Experience gained in the branch office of an Authorized Employer situated outside Hong Kong will also be recognized. For QP students under the MEPE working in the Mainland but not under an AE/AS, they may fulfill the practical experience requirements if their employers satisfy certain quality assurance criteria such that they will be regarded as having worked under a structured training environment of a standard equivalent to the PEF.

#### **Practising Certificate**

A CPA who wishes to sign statutory audit reports must apply to the Institute for a Practising Certificate (PC). The applicant needs to meet additional requirements, including ordinarily resident in Hong Kong, PC examinations, auditing experience, continuing professional development, and non-bankruptcy requirements, etc. CICPA members who qualified as a CPA member of the Institute by taking Module D (Taxation) and Final Examination of the QP under the MEPE are required to sit the PC-Law paper for PC issuance purpose. Those who have not sat and passed the Auditing paper in the PRC CPA Uniform Examination of CICPA are required to sit the PC-Auditing and PC-Law papers. #### Supplementary Note for Mainland China university degree holders

#### Student Registration Requirements

Under the Institute's Qualification Programme (QP) entry policy, direct admission of Mainland accounting graduates to the QP is based on a case-by-case assessment of the applicants using the following three criteria:

(i) The applicant should be a recognised accounting degree holder from a Mainland university or degree-granting institution under one of the following categories:

Category A	Tertiary institutions directly affiliated with the PRC Ministry of Education (教育部直屬高等學校)
Category B	Tertiary Institutions accredited by the Chinese Institute of Certified Public Accountants (中國註冊會計師協會)
Category C	Tertiary institutions recognised by the PRC Ministry of Education, which offer accountancy degree programmes and are located in Beijing (北京市), Shanghai (上海市), Guangdong province (廣東省) and Fujian province (福建省)

- (ii) The applicant should have achieved one of the following English competency standards:
  - Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
    - Paper-based test: a score of 550 or above; or
    - Computer-based test: a score of 213 or above; or
    - Internet-based test: a score of 79 or above
  - International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
    - Overall band of 6.5 or above
  - Chinese Mainland's College English Test (CET)
    - Band 6: or
    - A total mark of 450 or above in the new CET-6
  - Overseas General Certificate of Education /
     International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)
    - Grade C or above
  - Cambridge Test of Proficiency in English Language (Cambridge Test)
    - Grade C or above for English taken as the first language; or
    - Grade B or above for English taken as the <u>second</u> language

  - Public English Test System (PETS)
    - Band 5
  - Other equivalent qualifications acceptable for this purpose





#### Conditional Enrolment

Applicants who have achieved the following **minimum English competency standards** for QP entry will be conditionally admitted to the QP and allowed to take the QP modules. However, they must have achieved the prescribed English standard before being allowed to enroll in the Final Examination of the QP.

- International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
  - Overall band of 6.0 or above
- Chinese Mainland's College English Test (CET)
  - Band 4: or
  - A total mark of 450 or above in the new CET-4
- Public English Test System (PETS)
  - Band 4
- (iii) The applicant should have met the QP's admission competency requirements in the undergraduate degree, i.e. with adequate coverage of Financial Reporting, Management Accounting, Financial Management, Auditing, Taxation, Business Law, Company Law, Management Information Systems, Economics, Statistics, Marketing and Ethics. For those who have deficiency in the competency areas required, they have to take a HKICPA accredited Conversion Programme (full programme or single subjects) before they are allowed for QP registration.

#### Practical Experience Requirements for CPA Membership

In order to meet the requirements for CPA membership of the Institute, apart from successful completion of the QP professional examinations, students are also required to comply with the competency-based Practical Experience Framework. For relevant experience gained outside Hong Kong by registered students on or after 1 January 2005, such experience will be recognized only if it is gained under an Authorized Employer / Supervisor (AE/AS). Experience gained in the branch office of an Authorized Employer situated outside Hong Kong will also be recognized. Practical experience other than those gained under the AE/AS will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

#### **Practising Certificate**

A CPA who wishes to sign statutory audit reports must apply to the Institute for a Practising Certificate (PC). The applicant needs to meet additional requirements, including ordinarily resident in Hong Kong, PC examinations, auditing experience, continuing professional development, and non-bankruptcy requirements, etc. CPA members who have successfully completed the whole QP (passed the four QP Modules and the Final Examination) are exempted from taking the PC Examinations. However, QP-graduate members with non-Hong Kong accountancy degree who wish to apply for a PC are required to sit and pass the Aptitude Test – Hong Kong Law if they have not taken Hong Kong law subject(s) in a HKICPA accredited accountancy degree or conversion programme. This requirement is applicable to those who register as QP students on or after 1 January 2008. For details of the PC issuance requirements, please refer to the Institute's homepage.
