As Asian wealth management gains momentum, the demand for services to support the growth of wealth management in Asia will continue to rise. Will Asian families tap on the professional services offered by family offices to cope with their need for wealth creation, wealth preservation and wealth transfer to future generations? To what extent would these families let go of their tight reign and entrust their wealth planning to professionals such as those running family offices? What is a family office? What are the services of a family office and what is the typical profile of those working in a family office? Are they mainly investment managers? Accountants? Trustees? Lawyers? Bankers?

In this seminar, participants will understand:

- The role, types and structure of a family office and relevant studies
- Family office constitution
- Single and multi-family office
- · The role of an accountant in supporting families, family businesses and family offices

With the speaker's deep insights and decades of experience in Asian wealth management, he will highlight the principles, concepts and practical implications of running a family office for Asian families, and will let the participants understand why 'Fu Bu Guo San Dai (富不過三代)' can be rebutted with 'San Dai Tong Tang, Wu Shi Qi Chang (三代同堂、五世其昌)' (i.e. 3 generations under one roof, 5 generations of prosperity).
