

Go – Karting in Shenzhen



The Institute is organising a go-karting weekend at **Xtreme Speedway** in Shenzhen. This will be a great experience for motorsports enthusiasts. Whether you are a first-timer or an experienced go-kart racer, you are welcome to join this exciting sport event.

Xtreme Speedway is the only A-grade national race course in the Shenzhen area which is qualified for national racing events. It is one of the closest and best go-karting venues in the Hong Kong – Shenzhen area fully equipped with safety gear, electronic scoreboard, and spectator viewing area.

Participants' safety is of paramount importance and all participants are required to strictly observe the rules and regulations of the race course and the instructions of the event's leader, Michael Wong. The Paramedic Extrication Support Rescue Team will be there to offer on-site paramedic support.

* There are a number of factors that determine who should be placed in the intermediate (80cc) or experienced (100cc) racers. The event leader has full discretion in grouping the racers and all racers should abide by his decision.

- Racing suit, helmet, gloves and instructions are provided. Participants may bring their own gear if they wish.
- Bad weather arrangement: The activity will be cancelled if typhoon signal no. 8 or above/ Black rainstorm warning is hoisted 2 hours prior to the commencement of the activity. In accordance with the policy of Xtreme Speedway, no enrolment fee will be refunded but can only be used for the same event at a later date.
- This event is covered under the Institute's group personal accident insurance.
