Accredited programmes for QP

The Institute, in collaboration with the Open University of Hong Kong, has developed a blended learning top-up degree programme for graduates of the Hong Kong Institute of Accredited Accounting Technicians Limited, a subsidiary of the Institute. The programme, bachelor of professional accounting with honours, aligns closely with HKIAAT's professional bridging examination (PBE) by embedding the PBE syllabi into the programme curriculum. The accreditation of the programme is valid up to June 2014.



In addition, the Institute's accountancy accreditation board has approved the bachelor of management (accountancy) programme offered by the University of International Business and Economics (對外經濟貿易大學) in the mainland for direct QP admission. The accreditation covers the programme's graduates in 2009, 2010 and 2011.

Furthermore, the board has approved the re-accreditation of the following accountancy programmes for QP admission, with the validity ending month indicated in parenthesis:

- Bachelor of accountancy (Hong Kong), University of South Australia (in collaboration with the School of Continuing Education, Hong Kong Baptist University) (December 2013)
- PricewaterhouseCoopers conversion programme, PwC (July 2014)
- KPMG / Kaplan conversion programme, KPMG (July 2014)
