課程內容：

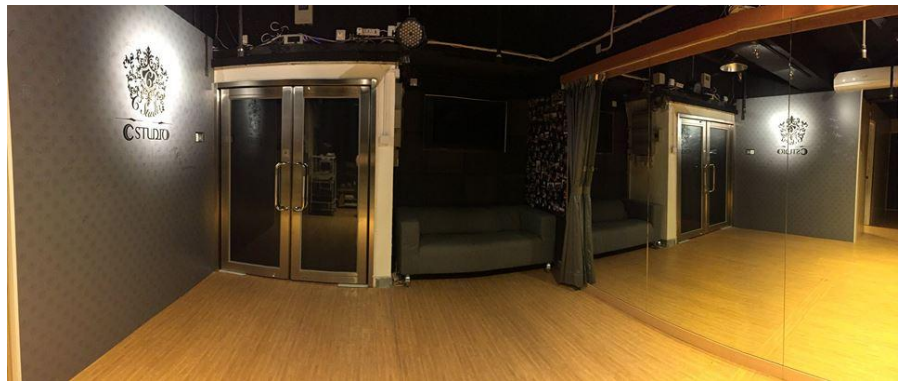
- 主音與和音之間的分別和關係；
