

## HKICPA seminar: Challenges in PRC Tax Risk Management

China has always been calling for more international collaboration in cracking down cross-border tax avoidance. Over the years, the State Administration of Taxation (SAT) have introduced various measures to counterfeit tax evasion arrangements. These measures include an introduction of new rules of taxing non-residents, more stringent requirements for deduction of fees and expenses, implementation of transparent reporting mechanism and more aggressive tax audits and investigations etc.. Lack of awareness or failure to meet these requirements would potentially expose businesses to severe tax consequences. It has become more challenging and is no more an easy task to manage tax risks effectively.

During the seminar, the speaker will discuss about various regulations and new measures that the Chinese Tax Authorities have introduced over the last 6-8 months and their significant impact on companies or individuals investing or operating in China. The key areas to be covered include:

- Tax considerations of indirect transfer of Chinese assets and how to restructure business effectively
- What to look for when implementing service fee arrangement and ultimately getting payment out of China
- What to expect in the development of tax collection and general anti-avoidance in China
