Insolvency Preparatory II

The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants invites applications for the Insolvency Preparatory II 2010. The course will be held on five Saturday mornings commencing 22 May 2010. Upon completion of the course, a certificate of attendance will be awarded to each participant who has fulfilled the required attendance*.

This Course offers an in-depth and integrated study of the financial, management, legal and accounting aspects of insolvency administration with specific emphasis on the practical issues relating to these areas. A multiple-choice test on understanding and assimilation of the knowledge taught will be held at the end of the course.

- Role of the Official Receiver
- Role of Special Managers
- Consequences of Insolvency Assets / recoverable property / trust assets
