- The competition takes places at the Dance Fun Night on 1 October and results are announced the same evening. First, second and third place are awarded with trophies.

- No entry fee is required.
- The competition will be cancelled if there are less than 5 entries. If the number exceeds 5, the competition will be divided into preliminary and final rounds all taken place in the same evening.
