The best 18 scores (total stableford points for each player gained from the calculated NNP handicap for the match) from each profession will be added to determine the total score of the team. The professional body which gets the highest team score shall be the champion.

Maximum Handicap: Maximum handicap of 24

Maximum players : North Course - 8 players (with lowest handicaps)
South Course - 14 players

Prizes : - The perpetual trophy will be awarded to the Champion team and medals to the champion, 1st and 2nd runner up team members.
- Special trophies to the players with the Best Gross Score (separate prizes for North Course and South Course) and the Highest Stableford points (one prize for both course) from each team.
- Prizes for winners of Nearest to Pin and Longest Drive competitions for North Course and South Course. Separate prize for men and women for the Longest Drive in the South Course.

Dinner : Dinner will be held immediately after the Tournament at the function room of the golf course. Presentation of prizes will take place during the dinner.
