- 2. Each applicant should submit only ONE enrolment form for the course(s) they would like to enrol.
- 3. Once the application is submitted, no withdrawal of application or refund of course fee will be allowed unless the application is rejected due to course over-subscription or cancellation.
- 4. Non-Institute members enroled for the December 2007 PC Examinations can also apply for the Revision Courses. However, in the event of over-subscription, priority will be given to members and students of the Institute.

- Application deadline: 1. All applications must reach the Institute on or before Thursday, 27 September 2007.
 - 2. Applications which are submitted in person will be post-dated by 2 working days for processing.
 - 3. No reservation is accepted.
