

CPA Football Competition 2011



- Dates : Sunday, 9 January 2011 (1st match) Depending on the number of participating teams, matches will be held in the weekend of January to March 2011.
- Venue : Kowloon Tsai Park (hard-surfaced pitch)

Entry requirements

This is a 7-a-side competition and each team can register a maximum of 15 players. Institute's members, registered students and CPA practices are welcome to form their own teams for the competition.

For details on the team requirements, please refer to the entry form.

Awards

Charles Mar Fan Cup will be awarded to the champion.

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up.



Number of teams

The maximum number of participating teams is 24. In the event of over-subscription, the Institute will draw lots to determine which teams will participate in the competition.

The competition will be cancelled if the number of teams enrolled is below 8.

To enrol, please complete the enrolment form and return it with full payment to the Institute on or before <u>22 December 2010</u>.

\$1,200 per team plus a deposit of \$500

(The deposit will only be refunded if the team has completed all scheduled matches, otherwise the deposit will be forfeited.)

(b) Enrolment is on a first-come-first-served basis. An email will be sent to you before 31 December to confirm if the competition will proceed and the status of your registration.

¹ Mobile phone will be used for communications on the event day, whereas email will be used for all general communications regarding the competition.

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Notes on Enrolment

- 1. Completed entry form together with payments should be submitted to the Institute on or before the closing date of enrolment, i.e. **22 December 2010**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late applications.
- 2. The entry fee of \$1,200 per team is non-refundable once the enrolment is accepted.
- 3. Each team has to pay an additional deposit of \$500. Such payment is intended: (1) to discourage absence from matches which will have a grave impact on the overall competition; (2) to discourage any team to make unsubstantiated complaints against other teams; and (3) to be used as a penalty for any team which is found guilty of breaching of the rules and regulation of the competition.

Therefore if any teams have not shown up at any scheduled matches; or made any unsubstantiated complaints; or been found guilty of breaching of the rules and regulations of the competition, they will face the consequence of having their deposit forfeited.

- 4. All players are required to present their HKID card or passport for identification purpose before the commencement of the match. Affinity Credit Card / HKICPA Membership Card / HKICPA Student Card are also accepted as a form of identification. The name appears on the List of Players should be identical to the name appears on the identification proof.
- 5. Any team players who are neither a HKICPA member nor a HKICPA registered student are required to submit a certification of employment status issued by his HR department or an authorised person of his company/firm in conformity with the Team Requirements as set out below.
- 6. The deadline for submission of certification of employment status is **28 December 2010**. The Institute has the right to request further particulars or proof in respect of any player's employment status as it sees fit.
- 7. The Team Leader is required to sign a declaration confirming that the particulars entered in the List of Players are true and accurate.
- 8. Should the Team Leader wishes to make any changes to the List of Players that has already been submitted, he is required to submit the Application for Change of Players to the Institute before the specified deadline, with certification of employment status, if applicable. The final composition of a team must comply fully with the Team Requirements as set out below.
- 9. The deadline for submission of any changes to the List of Players is **4 January 2011.** No changes will be accepted thereafter.
- 10. Only players who have been duly registered are allowed to play in the competition.
- 11. Each player should sign the attached declaration form and submit it to the Institute before the competition.
- 12. The Institute reserves the rights to revise or amend the rules and regulations of the competition as and when required. All rules and regulations are subject to the interpretation by the Institute.
- 13. The Institute may change the venue and date of the competition within short notice due to unforeseen circumstances.

Team Requirements

(a)

Participating teams should fulfill the following requirements:-

- There are three types of players:
 - i. HKICPA members;
 - ii. HKICPA registered students; and
 - iii. other players.
- (b) Other player refers to any person who is neither a HKICPA member nor a HKICPA registered student. This player must be a full-time employee of the same company with one of the teammates, who is a HKICPA member.
- (c) The Institute will base on the information stated in the entry form/Change of Players List to consider if a team has complied with the requirement set out in sub-paragraph (e) below. Any players who expect their status to be changed after 1 January 2011 may consider using the new status to enter into the competition so long as the change will take place before **9 January 2011**, being the first match of our competition. Any change of status after the first match of the competition will not be accepted.
- (d) A team can register a maximum of 15 players.
- (e) In a team, there must be at least three HKICPA members and the total number of HKICPA members, or a combination of HKICPA members and HKICPA registered students, must not be less than eight.
- (f) A team must have a Team Leader who is a HKICPA member.
- (g) A player can only register for one team.

Remarks: Please note that during a match, there must be a minimum of three HKICPA members playing at any time throughout the match.

(*A **full-time employee** shall mean a person who has been working for the company for at least **six months** by the time of the first match of our competition, **9 January 2011**, during which he is bound to devote the whole or substantially the whole of his time during normal office hours to his employment. Normal hours shall mean those hours at which banks are generally open for business in Hong Kong.]



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Declaration
