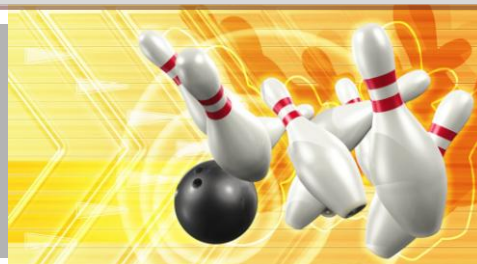




Bowling Summer League



The **Bowling Interest Group (BoIG)** cordially invites you to join Bowling Summer League commencing in May till September 2016. You may form your own team or we will help team you up with other CPA bowlers.

- Dates:** 27 May to 23 September 2016 (all Fridays; 14 sessions)
27 May; 3, 17 & 24 June; 8, 22 & 29 July;
5, 12, 19 & 26 August; 2, 9 & 23 September
- Time:** 8:00 pm – 10:00 pm (starts promptly at 8:00 pm.)
- Venue:** South China Athletic Association Bowling Centre (SCAA)
- Assembly time and place:** 7:30 pm at Section A area of SCAA
- Fee:**
- \$1,900 (HKICPA member); \$2,000 (non-HKICPA member)
 - Fixed fee. No pro rata payment or refund for not being able to participate all sessions
 - \$10 for shoes rental per session.
- No. of team:** Min 8 teams (max 10)
- Format:**
- Each team will comprise of 3 players, out of whom at least two players must be HKICPA members. Each team can have a maximum of 3 reserves listed on the team's roster throughout the league and they can be non-HKICPA members.
 - A total of 14 sessions will be held in the league season. Each player plays 3 games with handicap in each session.
 - At least half of each team's league games, i.e. 63 out of 126 games (3 games x 3 players x 14 sessions), must be played by HKICPA members.
 - Detailed league rules will be distributed to registered players.
(To comply with the lane booking requirement, at least one member of each team needs to be a current member of SCAA. If none, one of the teammates has to join SCAA membership at his own cost at HK\$100 for ordinary member.)*

- Team Champion, 1st Runner-Up and 2nd Runner-up.
 - Individual men and ladies high series.
 - Individual best improved players.
 - Weekly high game winners.

1. Priority for enrolment will first be offered to PoIG members and then to non-PoIG HKICPA members in the case of over subscription. Non-members' applications will only be processed after registration deadline subject to availability. We only consider non-member's enrolment when it is enrolled with a member.
2. The event is subject to cancellation should the minimum number of enrolment is not reached.
3. Full payment must be made before your enrolment will be processed. No telephone reservation will be accepted.
4. The closing date for enrolment is **20 May**. However, the Institute has the discretion to accept late enrolments as it sees fit.
