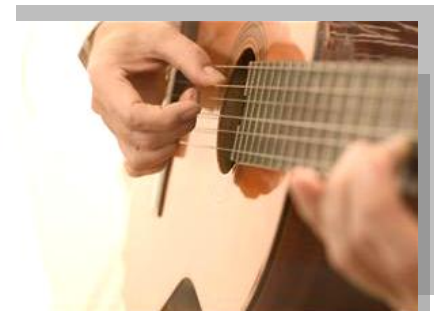




Acoustic Guitar Technique Class



The **Singing Interest Group (SgIG)** has organized an acoustic guitar class for members who wish to sing and play his own tune at the same time. Any interested members are welcome to join even if you have never touched a guitar before. The music teacher will use simplified music notes to teach.

About the programme and instructor

Participants will learn the basic techniques of playing the guitar, essentials of rhythm and melodic technique. The class will cover guitar playing in different kinds of music, such as jazz and pop songs.

The course will be taught by Mr. Derek Lai, a professional musician specializing in guitar. Derek has over 15 years of teaching experience in guitar and live performance. He is also a grade 8 acoustic guitarist and a certified professional guitarist.
